

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION

Highways & General Purposes Committee – 24th May 2023

005/24H **Public Participation:** The Public Participation session opened at 7.33pm.

Cllr Gibbs advised that he would like to speak about two items on the agenda:

Agenda Item 9.1 – Cllr Gibbs is Clerk to Soberton Parish Council, who are keen to use an Autospeedwatch Device. Some of the Soberton Parish Councillors are concerned that the device records vehicle registration numbers.

The Chairman advised that numberplates are retained and forwarded to the Police when Speedwatch sessions take place. In addition, a disclaimer sign is displayed where Autospeedwatch devices are located.

Agenda Item 10 – Cllr Gibbs suggested a Burial Ground sub-committee should be created.

Cllr Langford-Smith advised that in answer to the Autospeedwatch query, the device also enables the Police to detect untaxed and uninsured vehicles. In answer to the Burial Ground query, she advised that a Burial Ground Working Party had been set up for the drainage project and had been disbanded on completion of the project.

The Chairman requested that this suggestion be added to the next Highways & General Purposes Committee agenda.
