065/24H **Public Participation:** The Public Participation session opened at 7.33pm.

One resident joined the meeting.

The resident requested an update on the autospeedwatch statistics. The Chairman advised that the most up-to-date figures had been given at the Safer Neighbourhoods Panel meeting. The resident asked when the next figures would be available and was advised that this would be forthcoming presently, due to technical issues with the device due to the reduction in daylight hours at this time of year.

The resident further queried the Police response to the data captured by the autospeedwatch device. The Chairman advised that the Parish Council is still awaiting their response. Cllr Langford-Smith advised that she had written to the Deputy Police & Crime Commissioner Terry Norton and to the Sergeant present at the Safer Neighbourhoods meeting to say that the Parish Council look forward to working with them, as agreed by the Police & Crime Commissioner Donna Jones. The Rt.Hon. Suella Braverman MP KC had also been copied into the email and into subsequent follow-up emails. Cllr Langford-Smith further advised that she had had no response to her emails, and that the Parish Council cannot do anything else at present.
